Learn to Brew!!!! NEW Open Brew Days!!!

Don't have the equipment and or knowledge? Just want hang out and brew beer? What are you waiting for? Brew with Thorolf at the Vincog brewery, on the Baroness's estate, 417 Free State Dr., Shirley, NY, 11967. Take home wort or wait a week or two and take home beer. Kettle fire at noon. Check baronial calendar for dates.

One must contribute to the production costs and participate in the brewing process to be eligible for product. Once the yeast is pitched its beer and I can't sell beer. One must also provide ones own transport container or packaging, ie Primaries or carboys for wort and bottles or keg for beer. Estimated material cost is \$4.00-\$5.00 per gallon of wort. Supplies might be limited.

Every month we will try to do something different; style, ingredient, technique etc or explore in depth some basic technique of the process. December 13 **CANCELLED** Style and Technique. The WLP530 has served us well and we should have plenty of viable yeast so lets do two beers. We'll brew partigyle and brew a Barley wine with the first runnings and a lighter Beer with the second runnings.

January 10th (combined with Yule Commons and Baronial Business meeting)

Looking for suggestions for 2015. January - March we'll be using to lager yeast. I have to do a Märzen for Oktoberfest in March. March is also the month I plan to switch back to abbey ale yeast so it could go either way for that open brew day. April and May will be brewing with abbey ale yeast. June-August it's kolsch yeast. I really want to try making Berliner weisse with a sour mash, triple decoction and Kolsch yeast. In autumn were going back to English ale yeast and English and autumn beers in including another unspiced Pumpkin or squash beer. At some point we will have to do braggot, meads, and a wine in the fall, if there is interest.
